

We believe investment in international education programs in public schools is beneficial for sustainability and growth of international programs in a competitive, world-wide market.



Canada's public education system consists of schools from Kindergarten to Grade 12 (or Grade 11 in Quebec – see Why Study in Quebec for further details). All public schools in Canada are provincially accredited, follow a standard curriculum, employ only government certified teachers, and are publicly funded. While the education system in each province contains many similarities, each has its own curriculum and guidelines to reflect the culture and history of its region. Over 95% of Canadians choose public school education for their children.

Canada spends more on education (per capita) than any other country in the G8. Canadian public high school students consistently rank near the top in the world on standardized tests. Canadian high school graduation diplomas are recognized throughout the world.

Canada's public schools have been accepting international students since the 1980s and have well-developed infrastructure and support including ESL (English as a Second Language) instruction and carefully supervised homestay programs. Almost all public schools are co-educational and accept international students for high school graduation programs or for shorter stays of weeks, months or a year or two. Many elementary schools also accept young students for short term and full-year programs.

Most school boards offer non-religious education although in a few provinces some faith-based schools are also publicly funded.

Elementary*— Elementary schools provide educational programs for students from Kindergarten and Grade 1 through to Grades 4,5,6 or 7. These early years provide an important foundation for lifelong learning.

Middle* — Middle schools typically enrol students in grades 5, 6,7 and 8 however the specific grades offered may vary by school and region. Middle school prepares students for junior high and high school grades.

Junior High* — Junior high schools generally include Grades 7, 8 and 9 and provide a transition for students from elementary to high/secondary school.

Secondary or High Schools* — Secondary or high schools offer opportunities for students beginning in Grade 8, 9 or 10 to continue their studies through to Grade 12 (or Grade 11 in Quebec) to complete graduation requirements. These schools offer students more choice and opportunity to specialize in their particular areas of interest while preparing for post-secondary education and future careers. Where offered, qualified students may also enrol in the International Baccalaureate Program or take Advanced Placement (AP) courses.

* Specific grades may vary by school and region





Affordability & High Standard of Living

Each year, thousands of international students and their parents choose Canada as a study destination because tuition fees are competitively priced yet provide a high standard of living. The standard of living in Canada is among the highest in the world.

Choosing a School and Educational Program

All school boards/districts across Canada offer educational programs from Kindergarten through to Grade 12 (5-18 years) or Grade

11 in Quebec. However, which programs are offered to international students will vary. School structures and grade groupings also vary throughout the country. In Canada, international students can choose to study and live in small towns with rural settings, suburban, mid-size communities, or in larger urban cities. Selecting a school is an important decision, however all CAPS-I public schools offer the highest quality learning experiences in friendly welcoming schools.

All CAPS-I schools have knowledgable and well-trained staff to assist international students and ensure they are registered for the appropriate academic and optional courses to suit their language ability, personal interests, and future goals.

As students progress through the grades, they are provided with more choice of optional courses and specialized programming (subject to availability) including: Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, sports & fine arts academies, apprenticeship, and French Immersion opportunities to name just a few.

International students have a very comprehensive network of caring and supportive individuals that are ready and willing to assist at all stages of their learning experience. International students are also well supported and cared for outside of the classroom and school community as well. Most international students will live with a local host family and be in regular communication with the Homestay Coordinator.

All of the people involved in the students 'circle of care and support' are of course available to answer any questions from the parents of the international students as well. Parents of international students are encouraged to remain informed and in contact throughout their child's study program.





Unfortunately all experiences whether short or long term must eventually come to an end. International students either return home or move onto further their studies at the post-secondary level. International programs, homestays, and school staff also support students through this departure and transition process.

Living in Canada



Host Family Accommodations

Living with a host family provides an excellent opportunity for international students to develop conversational English skills and experience life as part of a typical Canadian family.

CAPS-I member homestay programs will provide a carefully selected Canadian host family including:

- a warm, welcoming, and friendly living environment
- parenting, support, and guidance
- a furnished private bedroom
- a study area
- 3 meals per day and snacks
- an introduction to the community

All CAPS-I programs adhere to prescribed practices to ensure that their host families are carefully and appropriately screened before they are selected into the program to ensure they are:

- · friendly and caring
- English-speaking (primary language spoken in the home)
- able to complete successfully a criminal record check with the local police department
- able to successfully complete a reference check process
- willing to welcome an international student into their family
- willing to include the student in their family and community activities
- interested in learning about other cultures and customs

Burnaby, 2016 and 2017 Star High School award winner, is located in the centre of the beautiful Greater Vancouver area. It offers the perfect combination of residential and city living and is only 20 minutes from downtown Vancouver.

International students may study alongside Canadian students in one of 8 secondary or 41 elementary schools. Students can start in September or February and stay for one semester (5 months), one year (10 months) or graduate with a British Columbia High School Diploma. Many of Burnaby's international students go on to top universities in North America.

Burnaby's focus on academic achievement is reflected in its student success. All Burnaby schools are accredited by the BC Ministry of Education and are led by highly qualified teachers and administrators. Burnaby houses the largest Advanced Placement Program in Canada and is proud that 2 of only 10 schools in Canada offer the prestigious AP Capstone diploma. Burnaby is also well recognized for its programs in robotics, gaming, cyber security, dance, drama, music and visual arts. All schools offer a strong English-as-a-Second Language (ESL) program.

International students aged 13 years or older are placed with a Canadian homestay family nearby their appointed school. Carefully selected families provide a safe, caring environment for students. Students under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a parent or relative.

The Cowichan Valley, situated on Vancouver Island, is a safe, beautiful rural area with a number of small communities nestled between Victoria and Nanaimo. It is very close to Vancouver, being just a scenic ferry ride away. The Valley has the warmest average temperatures in Canada. Activities include horseback riding, sailing, rowing, soccer, volleyball, field hockey, ice hockey, basketball, and many other sports.

School District No 79 offers one of the best educations in the world. Our District has four high schools, four middle schools, and twenty-one elementary schools with a combined enrollment of about 8000 students. The academic, sports, and performing arts (particularly film, drama and music) programs are some of the best in Canada. Computer technology programs and equipment are up-to-date and excellent, providing a cutting edge foundation for students to build on.

We have been hosting international students for over 25 years. We have one of the most experienced homestay programs in Canada, and have a full-time homestay manager to oversee the needs of our students. We are one of few programs that have ESL specialist teachers who work only with our international students. This ESL support is included in tuition costs, and is available throughout the regular school year.







Delta School District

Delta School District is located 30 minutes from Vancouver and has 33 schools in three communities and touches the USA border. Surrounded by water on three sides, Delta has beautiful beaches and natural environments.

Delta has very few ESL students with 90% speaking English as their first language (excellent English immersion). Delta has National Award winning teachers and the graduation rate is consistently among the top in BC. Delta has free airport pick up and drop off. We have continuous entry so students can start at any time all year long.

Delta has short term, full year, and graduation programs for elementary and secondary aged students. Delta has IB and AP programs for honors students. There are traditional schools with uniforms and elite academies in dance, film production, acting, lacrosse, golf, hockey, baseball, and soccer. All schools have a wide variety of clubs and sports.

Delta staff run the homestay and custodianship program personally (not out-sourced to a private company) so homes are monitored closely with 24 hour contacts. Delta residents are mostly college and university graduates with incomes 30% higher than the Canadian average. Delta staff run monthly sightseeing activity programs.

Welcome to Quebec

Located in the Eastern part of Canada, Québec covers an area equal to that of Spain, Portugal, France, Belgium, Switzerland and Germany combined.

Quebecers are known for their friendliness. Cordiality, simplicity and an open mind characterize social relationships in the street, in the workplace or at school. Quebecers place great importance on maintaining an atmosphere that promotes: freedom of expression, equal rights, and respect for differences. Quebec combines American-style economic development with the influence of European cultures.

Québec is becoming more diverse. The Francophone majority, Anglophones and aboriginals live together with people of diverse cultures and origins from all over the world. Québec encourages exchanges between cultures and closer relations between communities and recognizes what an enrichment diversity is. Moreover, everyone can freely choose their lifestyle, opinions and religion, while respecting the rights of others.

Québec has developed a culture that is vibrant, definitely contemporary and open to the world. Québec's festivals draw hundreds of thousands of visitors every year from all over the world. Québec also has a vast network of museums, art galleries and exhibition centres.



Quebecers enjoy a wide and diverse range of recreational activities and the four distinct seasons offer a wealth of interesting activities. In winter, there are 90 ski hills and about 40 cross-country ski centres with thousands of marked trails to choose from. In summer, golfers have hundreds of courses that are ranked amongst the best in Canada.

Quebec's education system has five levels: elementary (K-6), high school (7-11), vocational (skilled trades offered through professional centres), college (CEGEP 2-3 year programs), and university. Students in the province of Quebec who intend to pursue post-secondary education must attend CEGEP before enrolling in university in Quebec. CEGEP is an acronym for College d'enseignement general et professionnel, or "General and Vocational College". It is exclusive to the education system in Quebec.

Students complete one grade fewer in total (finishing in Grade 11) than all other Canadian students before beginning post-secondary studies. CEGEP then prepares the students for university or to enter a technical profession. Most Quebec undergraduate programs are three years, hence, the total number of years of study from elementary school through a Bachelor's degree is the same as in the rest of North America.

International students wishing to continue their university education outside of Quebec in another province or in their home country must take an additional one year of courses to fulfill the requirements of the university to which they are applying.





Central Quebec School Board

Since 1867, the Central Québec School Board (CQSB) has provided high-quality education to the English-speaking community of Quebec. Our geographical territory, the largest in Québec, covers nearly one-third of the province. 


